



# Alstom in Algeria

## An exceptional partnership

In the frame of its economic support and recovery programme, Algeria is pursuing some ambitious projects in the power and transport sectors. Present in Algeria for many years, Alstom supports this development of power-production and rail-transport infrastructures.

To better respond to the market needs, Alstom has significantly increased the number of permanent employees in Algeria. Alstom is also strengthening its presence in the country by cooperating with Algerian partners such as Infrarail, ETRHB, Baticim, on different projects.

#### Principal references:

- **Delivery of 16 3-kV electric locomotives** to the SNTF (Algerian national rail company) in 1998.
- **Beni-Haroun hydropower complex:** In 2001, Alstom was selected to design this pumping station. A € 90 million contract for the ANB (Algerian national agency for dams). The project was delivered in 2005.
- **F'kinira 300-MW power station:** built for Sonelgaz (Algerian national power and gas company). Commissioned in 2004.
- **25-kV electrification of 3 railway lines on the southern suburbs of Algiers:** This project, which includes the installation of 350 km of overhead power lines and 3 power substations, will allow a fleet of suburban railcars to be put into operation in March 2008. The contract, for a total of € 89 million, was signed in 2004 on behalf of SNTF.
- **Algiers tram system:** Alstom, together with its partners of the international consortium it leads, has been awarded a € 355 million contract for the supply of a turnkey system for the Algerian capital's first tram system which will link El-Annasser with Borj El-Kiffan areas. Alstom has a € 256 million share in the contract. The line is 16.3 km in length, includes 30 stations and 29 Citadis trams. The commercial commissioning by EMA is programmed for 2009. An extension of the line to connect Borj-El Kiffan and Dergana is already engaged. Once finished, the whole line will measure 23,3 km and will have 38 stations.

**Staff:** 320 employees of which 280 for Transport sector.

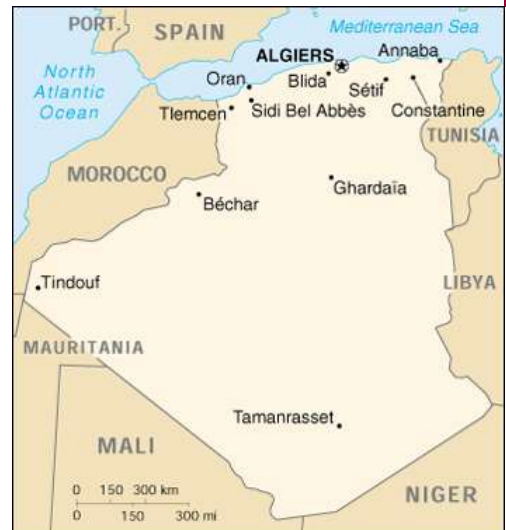
